TASTING NOTES: HERE, OUR LOVE OF BLENDING HAS RESULTED IN A MARRIAGE OF EXCEPTIONAL FRUIT AROMAS WITH CAREFULLY BALANCED ACIDITY, CAPTURING THE BEST QUALITIES OF THE AREA. HONEYDEW, ASIAN PEAR, ORANGE BLOSSOM, AS WELL AS CITRUS NOTES ARE HIGHLIGHTED IN THIS APPEALINGLY CRISP WHITE WINE.

The grapes for our Santa Barbara County Chardonnay come from a cool-climate vineyard within the area – Bien Nacido in Santa Maria Valley, American Viticultural Area (AVA.) After being whole cluster pressed and settled, the juice was barrel fermented in both new (28%) and older French oak. The lees were stirred every two weeks for four months, and the wine underwent a full malolactic conversion. The Chardonnay aged ten months in barrel before being released in November 2019.
