A match made in heaven! The 'terroir' found at Santa Catalina Island's El Ranch Escondido is unique in the world and its cool climate, morning fogs, ocean breezes and clay/loam soils make it the perfect place for Pinot Noir! In 2007, a blend of French Clones were planted in three small blocks, and due to row orientation and specific location at the ranch, each has its own micro-climate. When harvested, the grapes were fermented in 1 ton containers, with daily hand punch downs, and then gently transferred to French oak barrels. This beautiful Pinot Noir was aged in barrel for 11 months before being bottled without filtration.
