The grapes for this bottling of Pinot Noir hail from the Mt. Carmel Vineyard, which is located in the very center of the Sta. Rita Hills AVA. Harvested in the early morning, the fruit was quickly delivered to our nearby winery. Immediately upon arrival, the clusters were gently destemmed, placed into one ton bins, and cold soaked for 24 hours. Following this, the must underwent a ten day fermentation, with regular hand punch downs, then an extended 20 day maceration before being lightly pressed off. The resulting wine was aged in both new and older French oak barrels for 16 months and then bottled unfiltered.
